

French Syllabus
Les Aigles children club
11 years old



From 11 years old, children will continue to develop their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills through games, role-plays and projects, while working from the activity book “Les Loustics 3”.

Our learning objectives for each term are as follows:

TERM 1 (September to December)

- To be able to ask questions (*Comment tu t'appelles? Quel âge as-tu ? Tu as des frères ?*)
- To be able to describe someone (*Il est gentil et intelligent.*)
- To be able to count up to 100

During this term, children will begin to discover the conjugation of some verbs in French (*être, avoir, aller, venir*).

TERM 2 (January to March)

- To be able to describe a landscape (*Dans le parc, il y a des arbres, des fleurs...*)
- Discover the artist Claude Monet and his house in Giverny.

During this term, children will continue to discover the French grammar and new verbs.

They will work on the vocabulary of the environment (nature and garden) and the house.

TERM 3 (April to July)

- To be able to say what one did during the weekend, during a recent holiday. (*Ce weekend, j'ai joué avec mes amis*)
- To be able to say how you feel (*je suis fatigué, je suis malade, j'ai mal au ventre...*)

During this term, children will learn to speak about the past.

Discovery of the past tense “*passé composé*”.
